The children, pupils of peripatetic violin teacher, Mrs Kiely, performed jointly and individually.



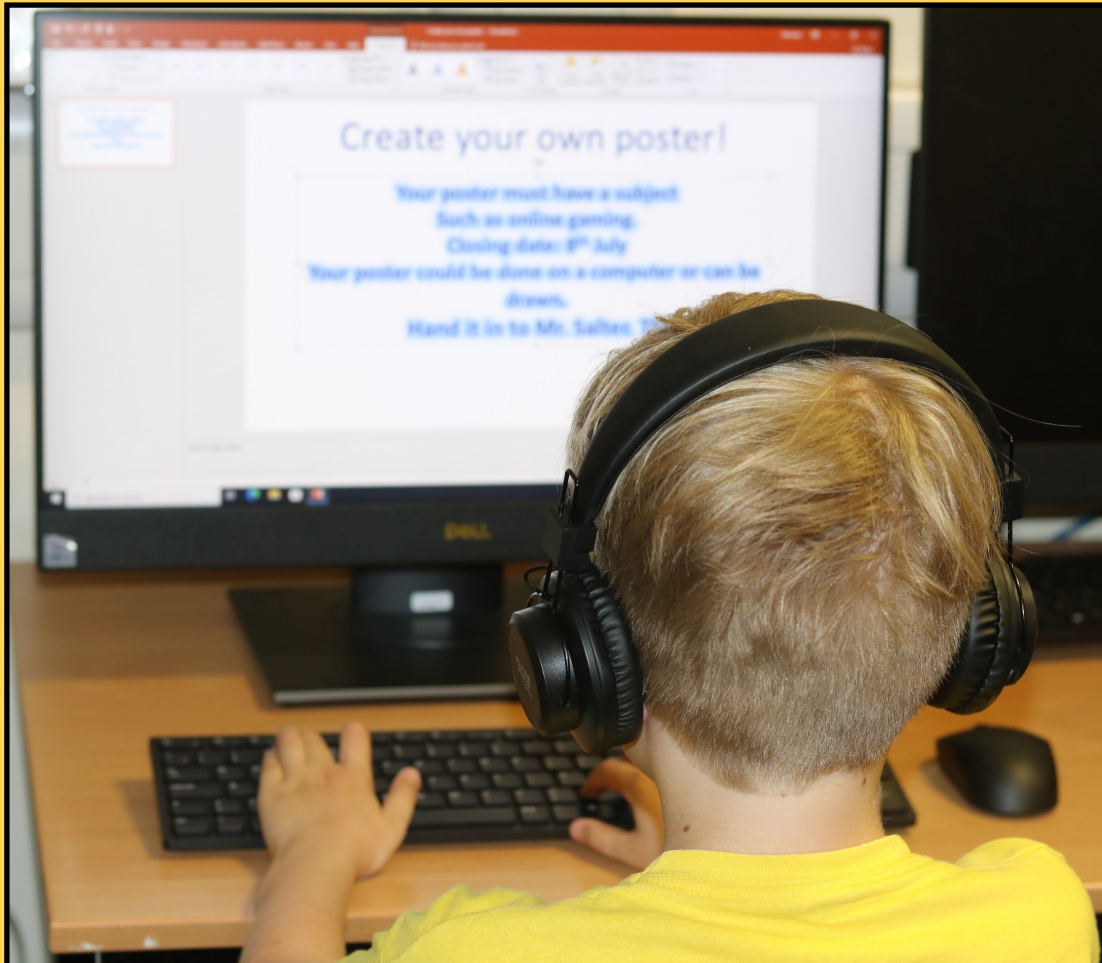
## OWN CLOTHES DAY FOR BRING A BOTTLE

## TOYS IN SCHOOL

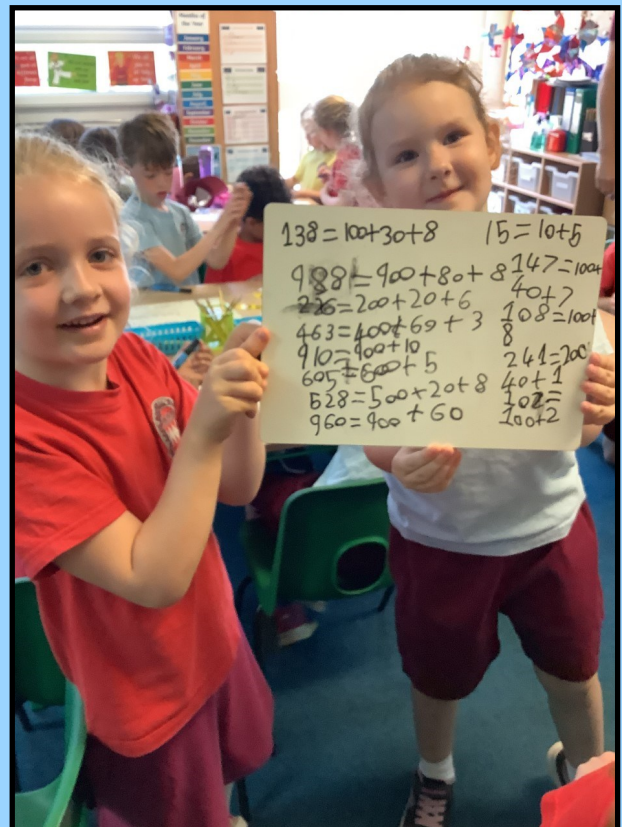
