LADY B'S SERVICE

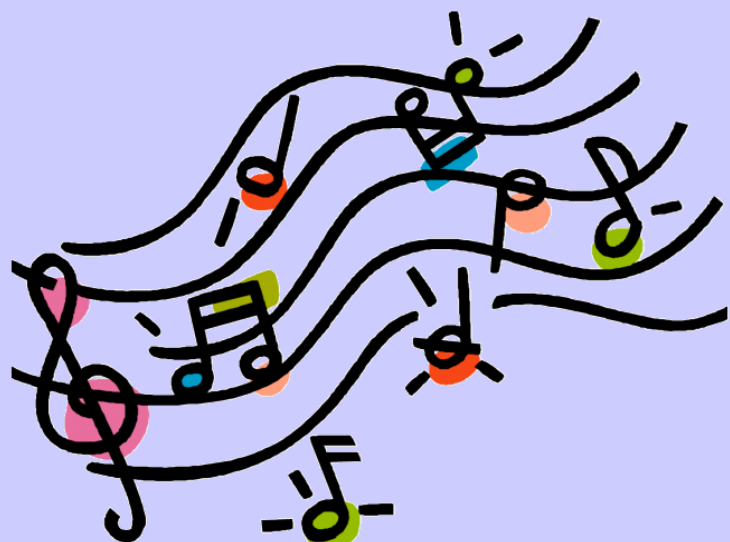

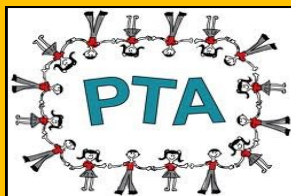


YEAR 5 TRIP TO GROSVENOR HALL

PTA CHRISTMAS CARDS

Further to the Parentmail from 27 September, launching this year's Christmas card project with APFS, here is a reminder of how to order:

The artwork is being created by the children during their art lessons. Once completed, it will be sent home so do keep an eye out for this. On the reverse of the artwork will be an APFS sticker with a unique code on it.

To order, you will need to visit the online shop at www.apfsorders.co.uk and input the unique artwork code, along with your child's first name and surname and then place your order.

Orders must be placed by midnight on **Tuesday 12th October**

Once ordered, you will then need to submit the artwork to the PTA. Please leave the labelled artwork in the labelled box inside the PTA cupboard (near the bike rack by the wooden gate) so that it can be sent to APFS for scanning. Please ensure your child's artwork has their full name and class on the APFS sticker before submitting to the PTA. Please **do not** return the artwork to class teachers.

The deadline for returning your artwork is **3.30pm Wednesday 13th October**. Any artwork submitted after this date will miss the deadline for APFS and nothing ordered online can be produced.

Please try to submit the artwork as soon as possible after you make your online order as the PTA team will be reconciling the two on a regular basis.

The cards produced last year were very high quality and you can also order wrapping paper, gift tags and mugs! We look forward to seeing the children's amazing designs reproduced in full colour! Thank you for supporting this initiative.

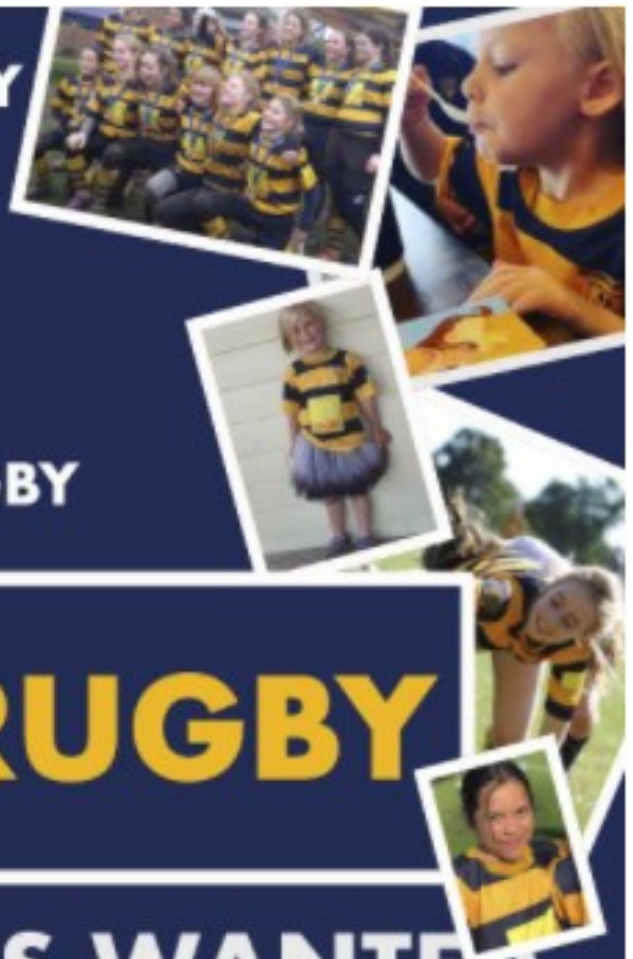
