CHANGE IN ADULT PICKING UP FROM SCHOOL

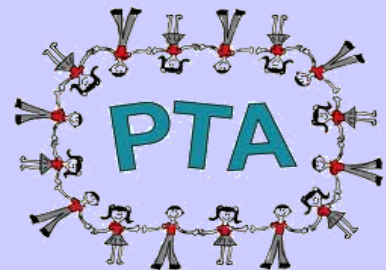
Please could we remind KS1 parents that, should someone different be picking your child up, you should let the Class Teacher know via their Contact Book.
