@900 EXHIBITION

2022 marks the 900th anniversary of the first mention of Sevenoaks in the *Textus Roffensis*, a manuscript held in Rochester Cathedral and, across the Town, there are plans to commemorate this.

One of the events taking place (planned by St Nicholas Church and the Sevenoaks Historical Society) is an exhibition featuring the lives of a number of important people associated with the Parish of St. Nicholas from across this period. One of the characters included in this exhibition is Lady Margaret Boswell, and we are proud to have been involved in preparing a panel in which we celebrate her life. This panel contains some beautiful illustrations created by three of our Year 6 children. JUBILEE CELEBRATIONS 25TH MAY 2022

ECO COUNCIL

Our very active Eco Council are delighted that Lady Boswell's families are taking advantage of the pen and battery recycling facilities that have recently been put into place. The pen recycling box is full already and the contents will shortly be wending their way to the Terracycle Collection Centre.

The Council met this week to discuss the 'The Big Plastic Count' initiative and were keen to share the details of this scheme with the Lady Boswell's community. TBPC aims to encourage the public to record the amount of plastic going into their bins (much of which is currently not accepted as recycling). The information gathered will provide data with which lobby the Government to ask them to put pressure on supermarkets to cut back on plastic packaging.
