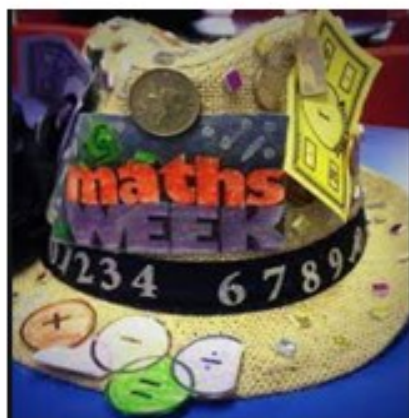


Just a reminder that the School will be celebrating all things mathematical between the 1st and 7th July.

The Year R Friendship assembly on the Parent Calendar for the 16th July, will be taking place in School during that week, but sadly, we are unable to invite Year R parents to attend.

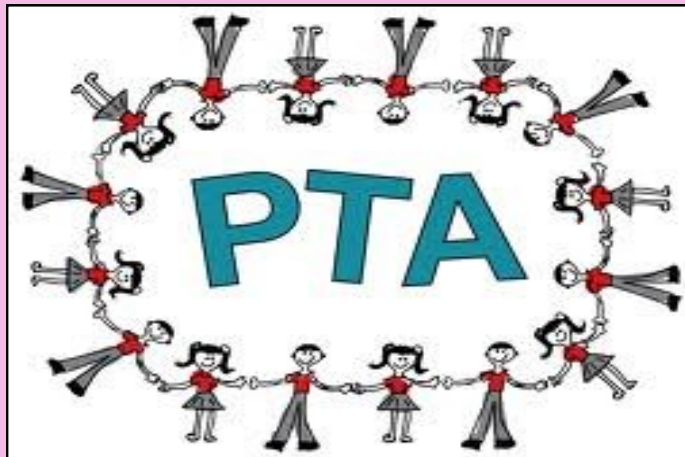

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT RE ACCESS TO SCHOOL SITE

With effect from next Monday, 21st June, both entrance gates to the School site will remain locked outside of normal school drop off and pick up times.
