Dear Parents and Carers

Sports Day is such a big part of Term 6, and the children enormously enjoy taking part and representing their houses. Our priority is the safety of our entire community but also to ensure that the children and parents/carers get the opportunity to enjoy this event. On this basis, we have structured the day somewhat differently to our normal format and a number of requirements/restrictions will apply.

Year 1 to 6 will be taking part in Sports Day in a staggered format on the 6th July with Year R taking part in their own Sports Day on another date (to be confirmed).

The timetable is as follows:

9.15am – 10.45am Year 6

11.00am – 12.20am Year 5

1.20pm – 2.10pm Years 1 and 2

2.20pm – 3.30pm Years 3 and 4

Parents for Years 5 and 6 events will be seated in house seating areas. Those attending for the Years 1 – 4 events will be seated in class seating areas.

Entrance to any of these events is reliant on the following:

- **Only 1 parent/carer can attend for each event**
- No siblings can attend with parents/carers
- Entrance to the School will be via the main gate only. A one way system will be in place at exit time – you will be directed to this route on the day
- On entry parents/carers will be required to use the Track and Trace system
- There will be no toilet facilities for parents/carers
- All parents/carers are required to wear a mask (please could those who are exempt wear the relevant lanyard to indicate their exemption)
- On entry all Parents/carers must go directly to the relevant seating area and remain in their allotted seating zone for the duration of the event
- Parents/carers are responsible for ensuring that they maintain socially distancing at all times
- Entrance to the site will be 5 minutes prior to commencement
- Parents/carers must exit the School site immediately after the event they have been watching has finished (even if you are returning for the following event)

In the interests of protecting all of our community, we reserve the right to ask anyone not adhering strictly to these rules to leave the site immediately.

We have booked professional photographers DE Photography to attend on the 6th July, and photograph the events. On this basis, it will be possible to view photos of the Year 1 – 6 events (via a password protected link) and to purchase professional photographs in the week following Sports Day. You will not be able to view or purchase the pictures on the day. We will aim to share photos of the Year R Sports Day via the Google Classroom class pages.

School lunches on that day will be a picnic 'grab bag' allowing the children to enjoy lunch outside alongside their friends who enjoy a packed lunch. Our School kitchen will be providing the picnic lunch for those children who normally have school lunches.

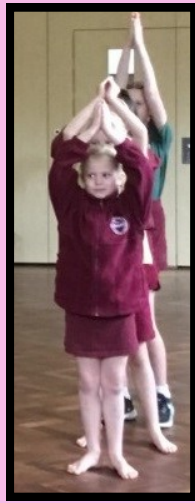
NO TRADING CARDS IN SCHOOL

Every year group took part this week in a fabulous dance workshop to promote this year's Olympic games.

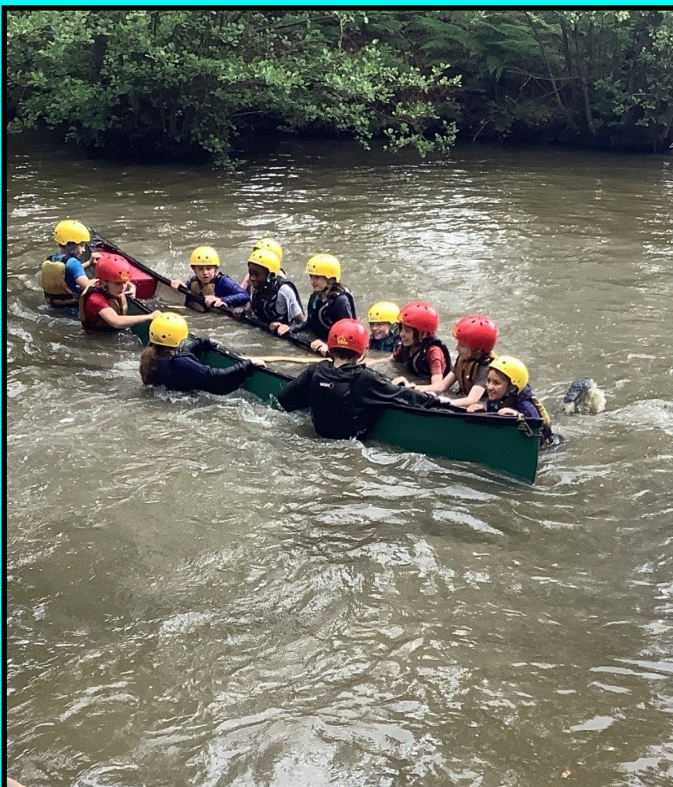
Every year group 'travelled' to a different part of the world and learnt a dance inspired by the culture and the music from that region.

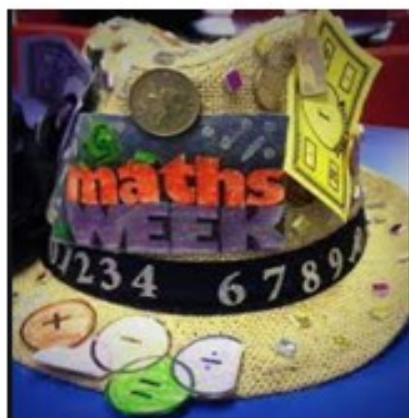


Our celebrations of all things mathematical started this week and goes on into next week.

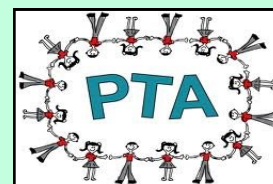
OUR THANKS TO THE PTA

Join the PTA Committee!

We would like to thank everyone who has been in touch and offered to get involved and devote some time to support the PTA. However, we are still looking for volunteers to take up key roles within the committee that are critical to fill in order to keep the PTA Committee going next academic year. Specifically, we are looking for a Vice-Chair and a Secretary. Both of these roles could be shared and neither involve a big commitment of time.

Vice Chair (VC)

The role of the VC is to act as a liaison point between school and the committee. Together with the Co-headteachers, who hold the position of Chairperson, the VC sets the PTA agenda for the academic year. In conjunction with the rest of the committee, they set the fundraising event calendar and fundraising targets and work with the rest of the committee to deliver them. No specialist knowledge is required, just enthusiasm and a desire to make a positive difference to our children's educational experience at Lady Boswells. You do need to be happy to lead meetings, and also ensure that members of the Committee and Class Reps feel included and part of the team!

Secretary

The Secretary of the Committee is responsible for organising meetings and working with the VC to set meeting agendas and record minutes. As a registered charity, there are formal documentation requirements but they are not onerous or unduly time consuming. Other than being organised and good at time management, there are no other specific skills required for this role. Outside of supporting events, this role doesn't demand a big time commitment as PTA meetings generally only occur once every half term.
