## At Lady Boswell's...

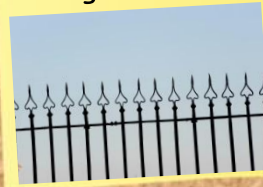


Every classroom has a **Worry Box**.

Our signing in system is a secure measure for allowing visitors and staff to enter our school building. Staff are aware of our colour-coded lanyard system and lanyards must be worn at all times.
